“Hawaiian Adventure: From Coast to Crater”
Featuring Oahu and The Big Island
Tour Dates: October 22 - 30, 2026

DAY 1 ARRIVE HONOLULU, OAHU – WAIKIKI BEACH

E Komo Mai! Welcome to Oahu, “the gathering place”! Upon arrival at Honolulu Airport, meet your tour director in baggage claim. Board motorcoach and transfer to Waikiki Beach. Check in to your hotel for two nights and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Stroll on the beach, explore the International Market Place, sip on a Mai Tai, check out an ABC Store or just relax at the hotel.

DAY 2 KUALOA RANCH TOUR – LUNCH – HALE’IWA TOWN – DOLE PLANTATION

After breakfast, depart for a full day of sightseeing. Take the scenic drive to the North Shore and en route, visit Kualoa Ranch. This working ranch is a historic site and offers a stunning backdrop of mountains, valleys and beaches. Enjoy a guided tour of this beautiful place, famous as a filming location for Jurassic Park, Hawaii Five-O, Lost and others. Afterwards, travel north and have lunch at a popular spot in an area known for aquaculture. Continue to Hale’iwa, a historic sugarcane plantation town, for some free time and shopping on your own. A short stop at the Dole Plantation for an included tasty treat. Return to the hotel for a free evening to discover more of Waikiki Beach on your own. (B,L)

DAY 3 CITY TOUR – PUNCHBOWL - PEARL HARBOR – FLIGHT TO HILO, HAWAII

Have breakfast before checking out, and depart on a city tour. See King Kamehameha Statue, Iolani Palace, Hawaii State Capitol, and more! Drive through beautiful Punchbowl Cemetery (also known as the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific) and continue to Pearl Harbor. Arrive at the Visitor Center before a boat ride to the *USS Arizona*. Stand on the deck of the *USS Arizona* Memorial, the eternal tomb for the 1,177 crew members trapped below. It is a somber and moving experience you'll never forget. This afternoon, take a short flight from Honolulu to Hilo, located on the eastern side of the Big Island. Upon arrival, transfer to the Hilo Hawaiian Hotel and check in for two nights. The evening is free for dinner on your own or to simply relax. (B)

DAY 4 KTA SUPER STORE - VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK – VOLCANO HOUSE DINNER

Have breakfast and the morning at your leisure. Depart for Hawaii Volcanoes National Park and en route, stop at a KTA Super Store (which are only found on the Big Island). Have some time to grab a bite or browse this locally owned 100-year-old grocery chain. Continue traveling south and arrive at the Welcome Center in the Park. This afternoon, tour this amazing park which was established in 1916. See expansive lava flows, volcanic craters, steam vents and dramatic terrain. Stop at Thurston Lava Tube for a short hike through the tube. Enjoy a delicious dinner at the Volcano House, located directly on the rim of Kilauea Caldera. Return to our Hilo Hotel. (B,D)

DAY 5 O.K. FARMS – HAWAIIAN VANILLA LUNCH & TOUR - WAIMEA, HAWAII

After breakfast, check out and travel north today. First, arrive at O.K. Farms, one of the largest tropical fruit producers in the U.S. Explore this 1,000-acre estate on a guided tour. See Rainbow Falls and take in the iconic views. Travel to the Hawaiian Vanilla Company, the first commercial vanilla operation in the US. Here, delight in an included vanilla-infused lunch along with a guided farm tour. Next, arrive in the rolling hills of Waimea, the center of paniolo (Hawaiian cowboy) country. Check into your hotel and have the rest of the day at leisure. (B,L)

DAY 6 PARKER RANCH & PUKALANI STABLES - HAMAKUA MACADAMIAS – KONA

Check out after breakfast and depart for Parker Ranch, one of the oldest and largest cattle ranches in the U.S since 1847. Take a self-guided tour of the historic ranch headquarters, preserved homes and grounds. Visit Pukalani Stables, showcasing the history of the paniolo (Hawaiian cowboy). Delight in a delicious lunch at a popular farm-to-table restaurant before traveling to Hamakua Macadamia Nut Factory. Here they produce 100% Hawaii-grown macadamia nuts. Enjoy sampling various flavors before a surprise treat. Arrive in Kona and check in to the Royal Kona Resort for two nights. Enjoy the rest of the day to explore downtown Kona. (B,L)

DAY 7 GREENWELL FARMS – HAWAIIAN CHOCOLATE – FARMERS MARKET – LUAU

Have breakfast this morning before traveling into the heart of the Kona Coffee growing region. First, a seed to cup coffee tour at historic Greenwell Farms. Get an inside look at the history, farming and processing of coffee. Next, arrive at the Original Hawaiian Chocolate Factory. Tour the cacao orchard, sample chocolates and learn all about the chocolate-making process from growing the trees to molding the bars. Stop at the Kona Farmers Market and find fresh produce, local goods and souvenirs. Return to the hotel and have time to relax before our farewell oceanfront Luau dinner show along with Polynesian entertainment tonight at the hotel. (B,D)

DAY 8 PU'UHONAU O HONAUNAU NAT'L PARK – KONA SEA SALT - DEPART FOR HOME

Enjoy our last Hawaiian breakfast and morning at leisure. Check out and depart for Pu'uhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park, a sacred Hawaiian site. This 180-acre national park was once the home of royal grounds and a place of refuge for ancient Hawaiian lawbreakers. Next, take a guided tour at Kona Sea Salt, the world's only salt farm that uses deep ocean water to create its products. Then, transfer to the Kona Airport for our overnight flight home. (B)

DAY 9 ARRIVE OKLAHOMA CITY

Today, arrive back in Oklahoma City. *Mahalo* for exploring with us and join us on our next amazing adventure!
